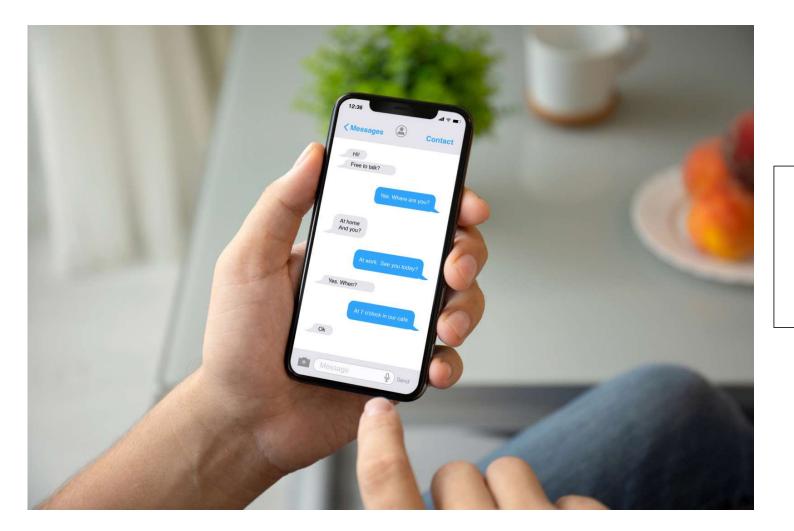

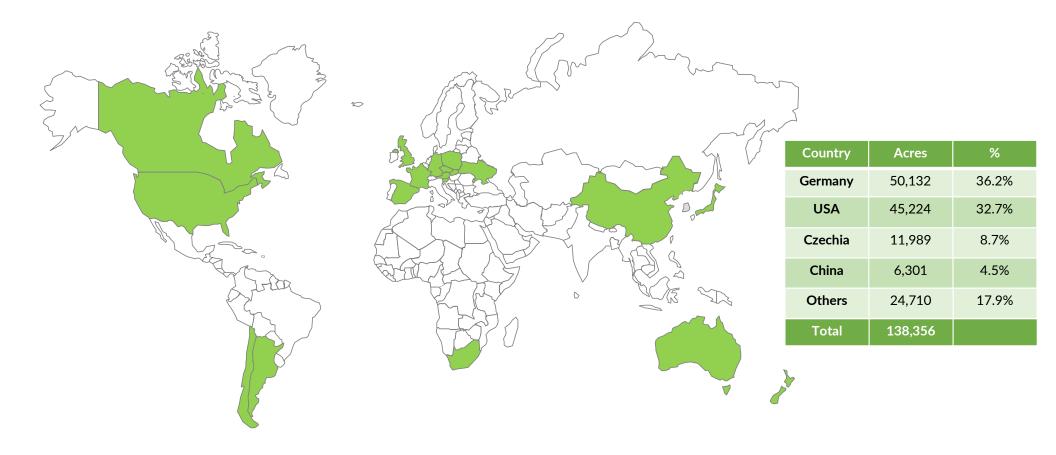

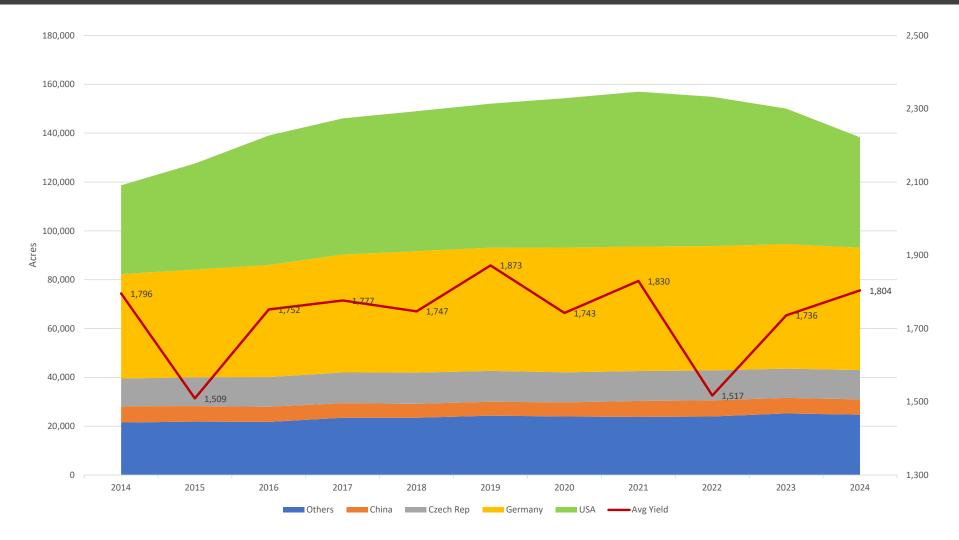

### Global Hop Acreage – Crop 2024

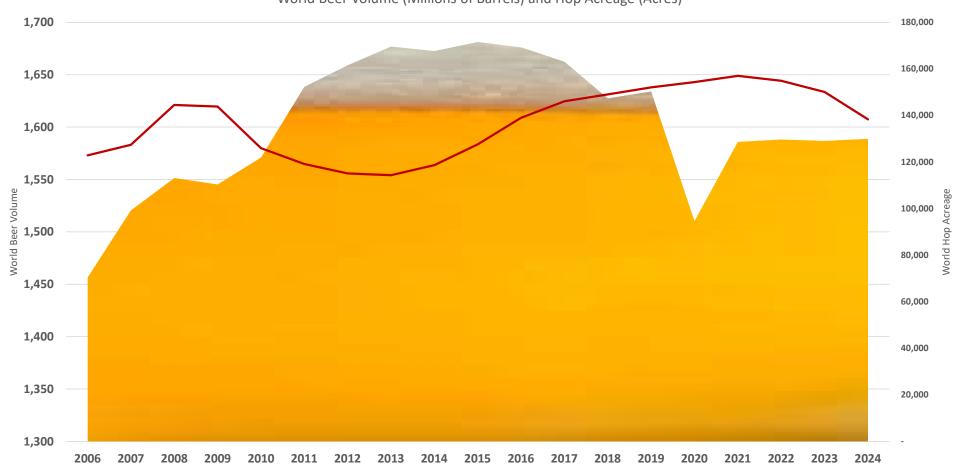


### World Hop Crop – Total Acres and Avg Yield (lbs./acre)

### World Beer and Hop Acreage

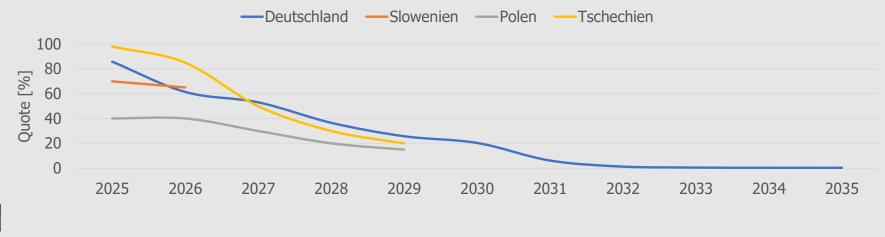


World Beer Volume (Millions of Barrels) and Hop Acreage (Acres)

# Recap From 2024 Merchant Panel Discussion







AVERAGE 2023 ESTIMATED GROWING COSTS WAS \$12,748.28 PER ACRE VARIABLE COSTS ~55% OF TOTAL COST, FIXED COST ~45% OVER 40 HOURS IN AGRICULTURE REQUIRES OVERTIME PAY IN WASHINGTON STATE



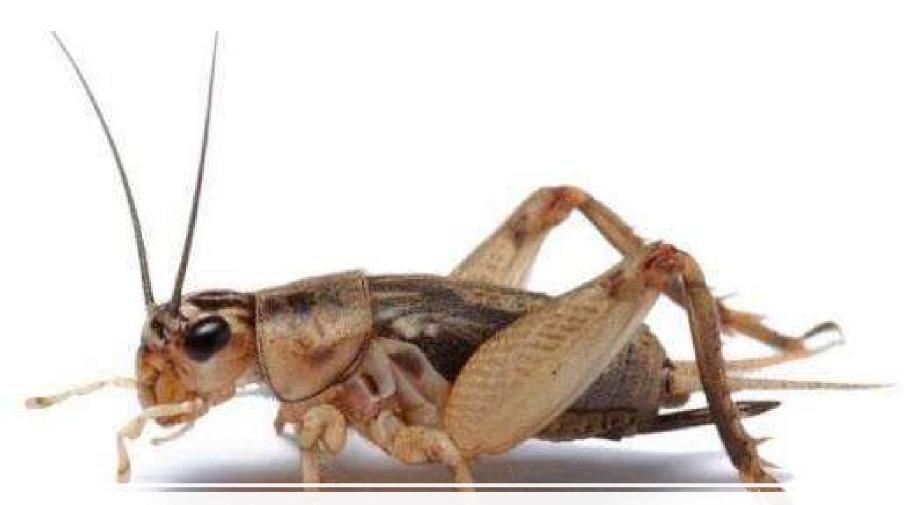
- Minimum wages increasing in WA and OR\*
- November CPI indicates a 2.7% inflation from 2023-2024, bringing estimated cost to \$13,092.48/Acre
- · Tariffs could mean material impacts on raw materials\*\*

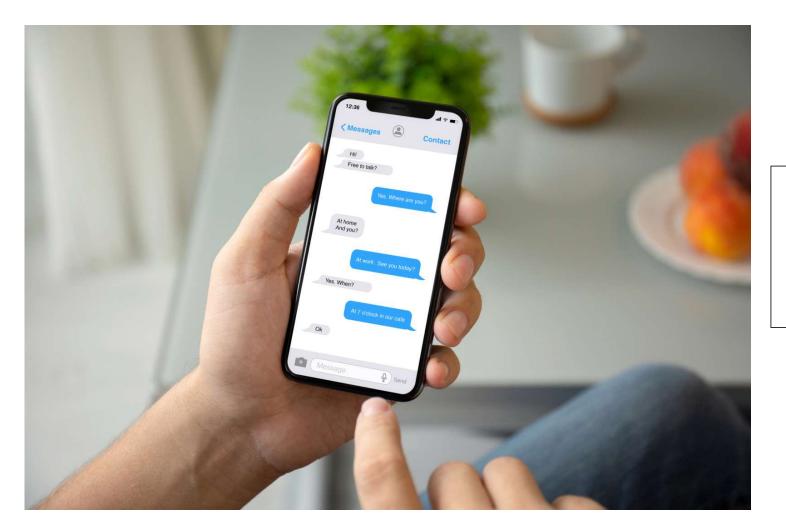

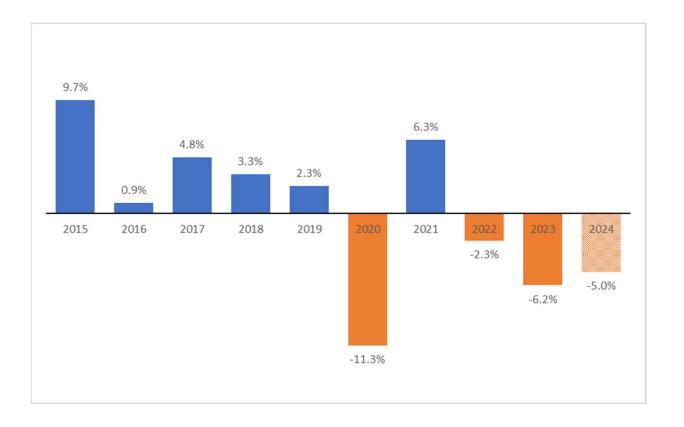

# Annual Change in <u>US Craft Beer Growth</u> Rates

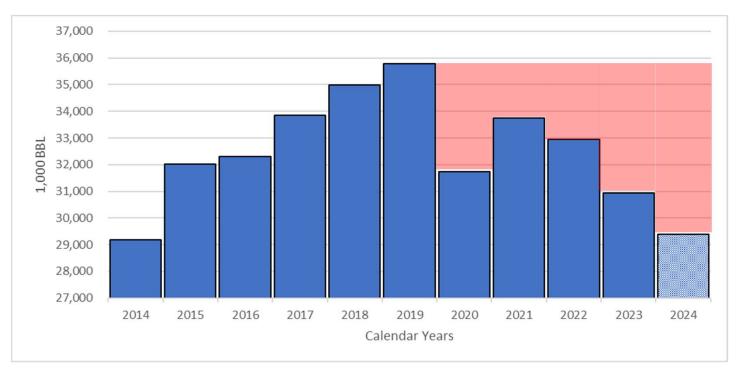
# WE ARE EXPERIENCING A DECLINING MARKET.



- Following 10 years of growth, US Craft has been declining since 2016.
- For 2024, US Craft is projected to post declines between 2% &- 5%.
- Brewer's Association estimated -2% based on their mid-year survey, but scan data has been trending less positive.

# US Craft Beer Volume (bbl) Development



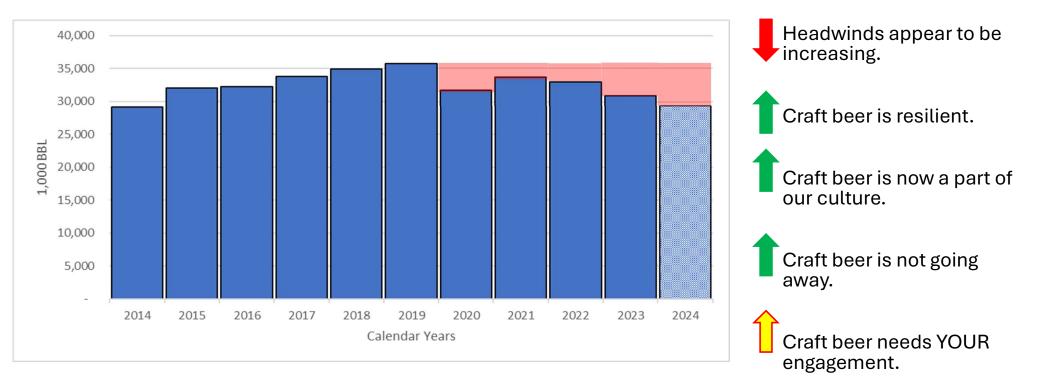
## **IS THE SKY FALLING?**

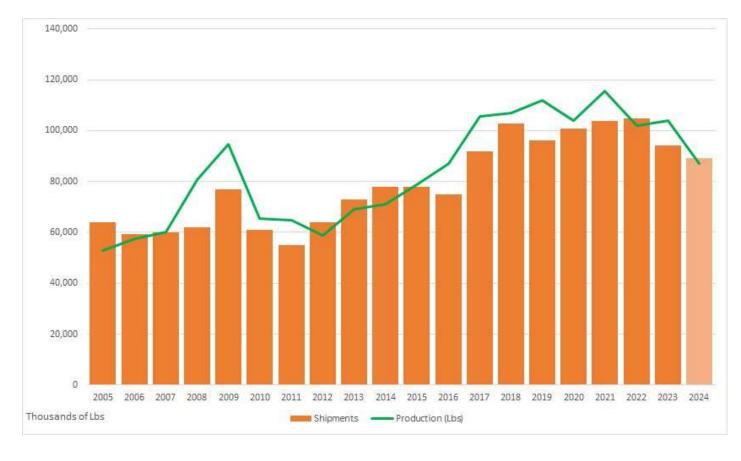

# HAVE HOPS ADJUSTED TO THESE CHANGES?

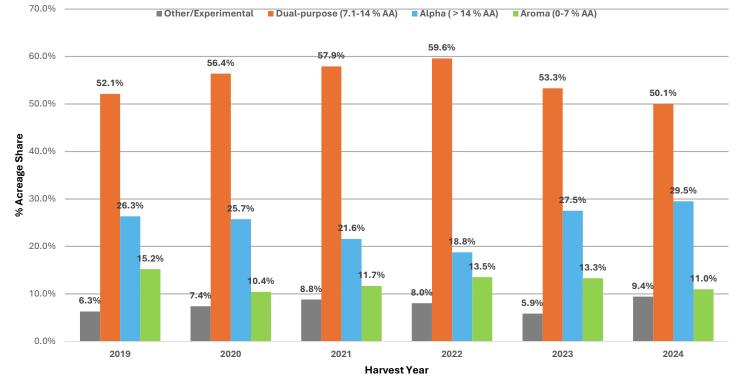


- In 2023 the US Shipped 94M lbs. of hops.

- Recent increase of other/Experimental acreage share in 2024.

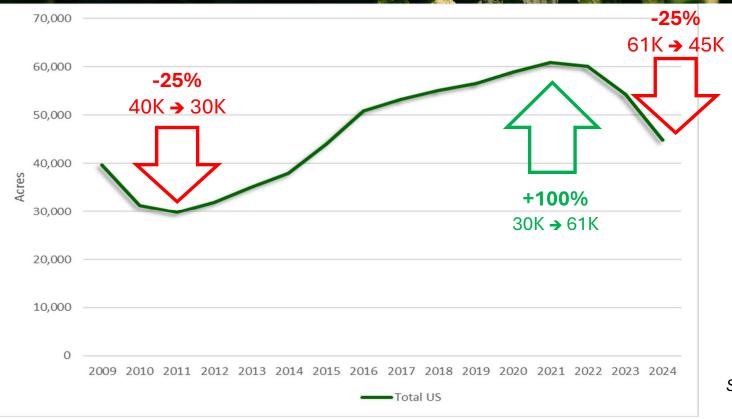

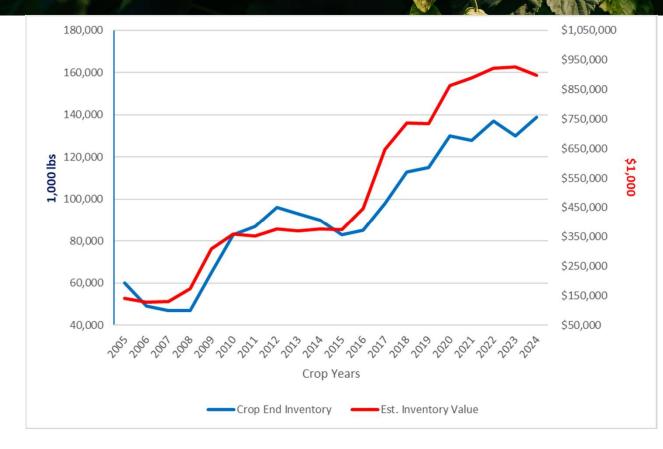
# US Acreage Development

- ~\$750M invested in past decade
- Creates significant financial benefits, but also burdens

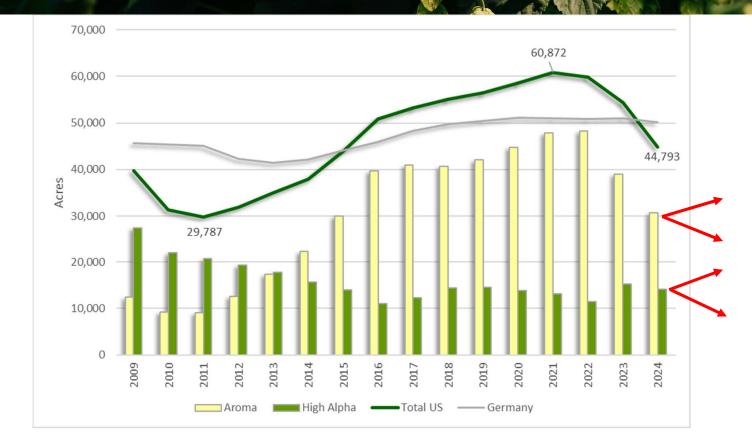
# Cost of Accumulated Inventory



- Prior year inventory:
  - ~ 139M lbs
  - ~ 16 months of demand
  - ~ \$900M, +240% since 2015
- Just prior to new crop
  - \$446M Farm Gate
- ~\$1.3B in total Inventory
- ~\$70M in annual interest on carryover stocks
  - In addition to new infrastructure and current crop
